The Lake Morey Protective Association (aka "LMPA") takes the confidentiality of your information very seriously. We have implemented appropriate physical, technical and organizational measures to keep your information secure, accurate, current, and complete.

The Lake Morey Protective Association will not sell, trade, rent, or disclose to third parties any of the information collected on this site. Member names, mailing addresses, and e-mail addresses will be added to the Association's mailing list solely for its use.

Members Section:

Member names, mailing addresses, and e-mail addresses are part of the Member Directory, which is printed and distributed to members bi-annually. It is included in the Members section of the LMPA website. This section is private, for members only, and requires that members register prior to being granted access. This section is password protected and will require the website administrators to review each request for access. If we are unable to confirm the identity of requester as that of one of our members, access will be denied until new or updated information is provided that confirms member identity.

We will endeavor to keep this section updated whenever new information is provided by our members. Here is how we handle information about your visit to our web site:

Non-Personally Identifiable Information Collected and Stored Automatically

If you do nothing during your visit but browse through the web site, read pages, download or print files, or use our search engine, we automatically collect and store only the following information about your visit:

- The Internet domain (for example, “xcompany.com” if you use a private Internet access account, or “yourschool.edu” if you connect from a university’s domain) and IP address (an IP address is a number that is automatically assigned to your computer whenever you are surfing the Web) from which you access our web site;
- The type of browser and operating system used to access our site;
- The date and time you access our site;
- The pages you visit; and
- If you linked to this web site from another site, the address of that web site.

This information does not identify you personally. In order to make our site more useful to visitors, we use this information to learn about the number of visitors to our site and the types of technology they use.

With respect to cookies: We use cookies to record user-specific information on what pages users access or visit, record past activity at a site in order to provide better service when visitors return to our site.

If You Send Us Personal Information

If you choose to provide us with personal information, as in an e-mail through the contact us form or mailing list request, we use that information to respond to your message and to help us get you the information you have requested.

No information, including your e-mail address, will be sold or distributed to any other organization. If you supply us with your postal address on-line you will be added to our mailing list.

With respect to security: We have appropriate security measures in place to protect against the loss, misuse or alteration of information that we have collected from you at our site.
